A deteriorating sewer lateral, a storm line with root intrusion, a conduit run buried and forgotten — none of it surfaces until a project uncovers it or something fails. At that point, the schedule slips, the scope changes, and the budget takes a hit no one planned for.

Underground infrastructure doesn't announce problems.

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Sewer camera inspection for commercial projects is how you get ahead of that. A CCTV pipe inspection gives contractors, engineers, surveyors, and municipalities a verified picture of what's in the ground — documented, reportable, and defensible when it matters.

What the Camera Shows You

A sewer camera inspection does more than confirm a pipe exists. It reveals integrity: cracks, deflections, root intrusion, offset joints, and structural failures that won't show up on any as-built drawing. For sanitary sewer and storm sewer lines, that documentation becomes the baseline — for repairs, for permitting, for municipal final inspections, and for the project record.

Three Camera Systems, Built for Commercial Projects

Not every line requires the same tool.

QuickView is for rapid CCTV assessment of sanitary sewer and storm sewer conditions. When a project needs a fast read on existing conditions — integrity, defects, what's there — QuickView captures it and gives the team what they need to plan next steps.

For smaller diameter lines — sanitary sewer laterals and conduit runs — our **Push Camera** provides clear insight into what's happening inside without a large mobilization. These are the lines that get overlooked until they become a problem.

The Crawler handles the larger scope: sanitary sewer and storm inspection of lines from 6 inches up to 42 inches, built for conditions that would stop a lesser camera. Beyond generating NASSCO inspection reports and footage for municipal final inspections, the Crawler lets our field technicians do something most CCTV providers can't — connect to the camera signal and mark the utility above ground. Engineers and contractors get a verified surface location, not just footage from inside the pipe.

Why Commercial Projects Need a Different Standard

Most of the first page of search results for sewer camera inspection in Charlotte is residential plumbers. That's fine work — but it's a different scope, a different standard, and a different deliverable.

Commercial projects — site development, utility relocation, pre-construction due diligence, municipality-required documentation — need NASSCO-certified reporting, accurate footage of line conditions, and a crew that understands what the documentation requirements look like on the other end.
